- Manual Farmer has his own ICAR approved Equipment on farm
 - > The MRO Sends a recorder to the farm who carried out the recording
 - > Records the yield and takes a sample from individual Cows
- EDIY Farmer has no ICAR approved Equipment so rents meters off MRO
 - > Equipment is dropped by a technician to the farm
 - Farmer carries out his own recording using our TRU –TEST Electronic milk Meters





Milk Meters and ICAR Approval



- What is ICAR? ICAR, an International Non-Governmental Organisation (INGO) that provides guidelines and standards for animal identification, performance recording and the evaluation of farm livestock.
- What does ICAR approval Mean with regard to milk meters and recording? ICAR approval is a stamp that shows a particular milk meter has met the Standards of the organisation and can be used for milk recording.
- Currently 58 Meters and 11 Jars have been ICAR approved since its formation
