TAMS II

- Targeted Agriculture Modernisation Schemes
- €395m over the lifetime of the programme
(2015 to 2020)
- Schemes are open for applications

Schemes

- Young Farmer Capital Investment Scheme (YFCIS)
- Dairy Equipment Scheme (DES)
- Low Emission Spreading Equipment (LESS)
- Organic Capital Investment Scheme (OCIS)
- Animal Welfare, Safety and Nutrient Storage (AWNSS)
- Pig and Poultry Specialised Equipment (PPIS)
- Tillage Capital Investment Scheme (TCIS)

General Principals (cont.)

- 60% grant aid for Young Farmer
- 40% grant aid for all other schemes
- Compulsory ranking and selection of all applications
- Reference cost for every investment
- Similar eligibility criteria across schemes

General Principals

- Online applications & payment claim
- Investment super ceiling of €80,000 per holding (€40,000 for LESS is independent of this €80,000)
- Farm partnerships (increase ceiling)
 - Non Less- €160k
 - Less - €60k
- Budget divided into Tranche, every three months

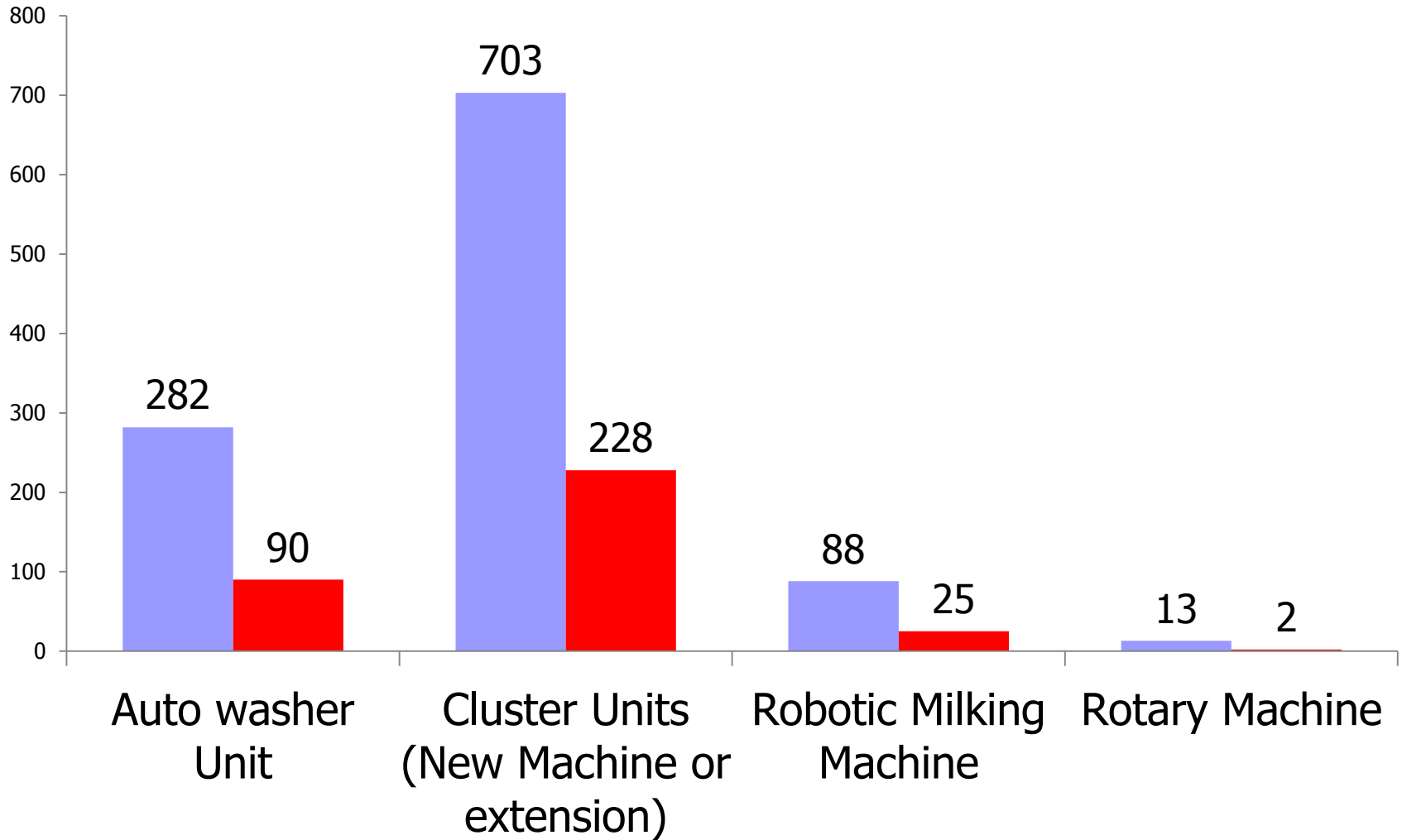

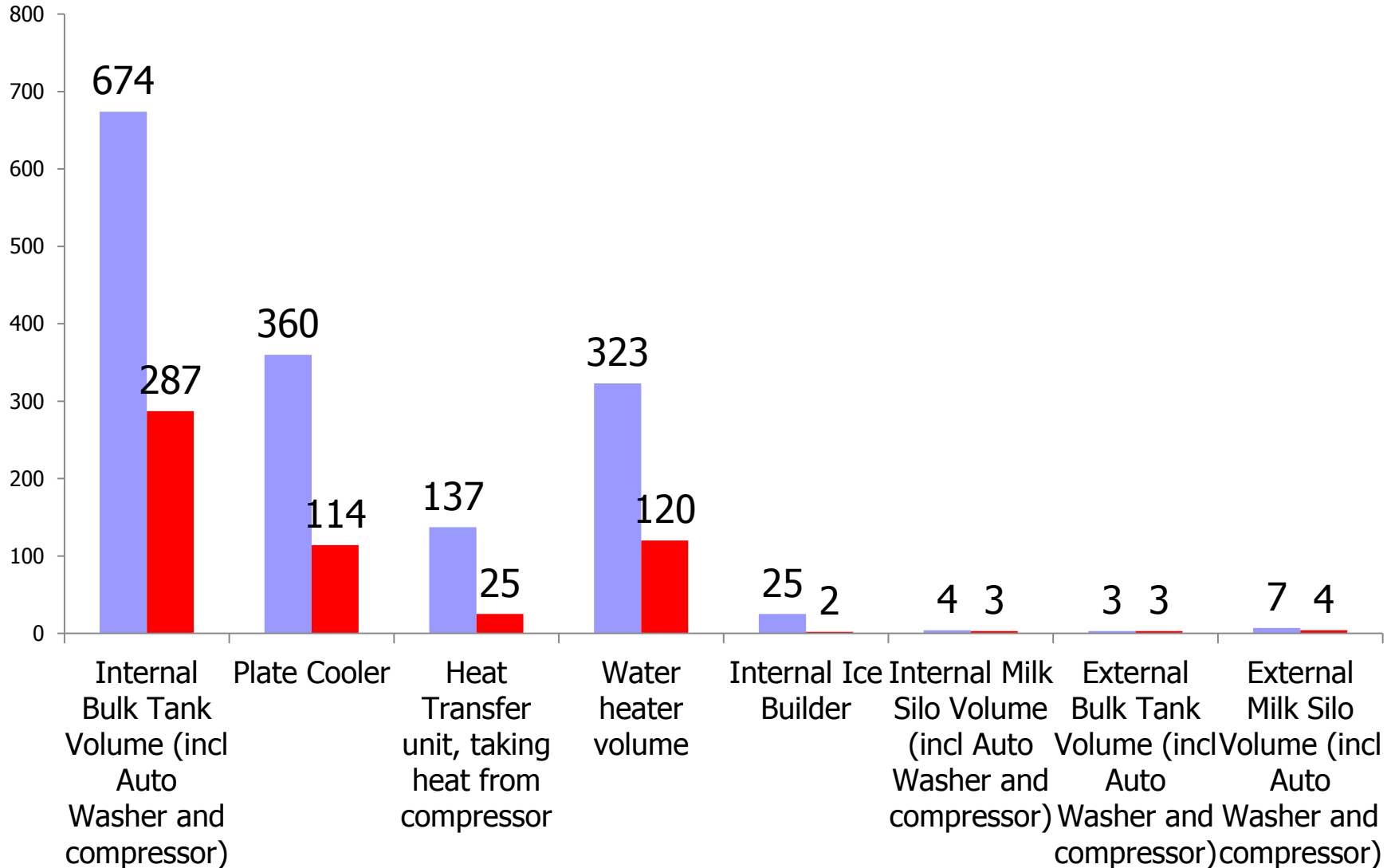
Milking equipment

(Blue = Applied, Red = Completed)



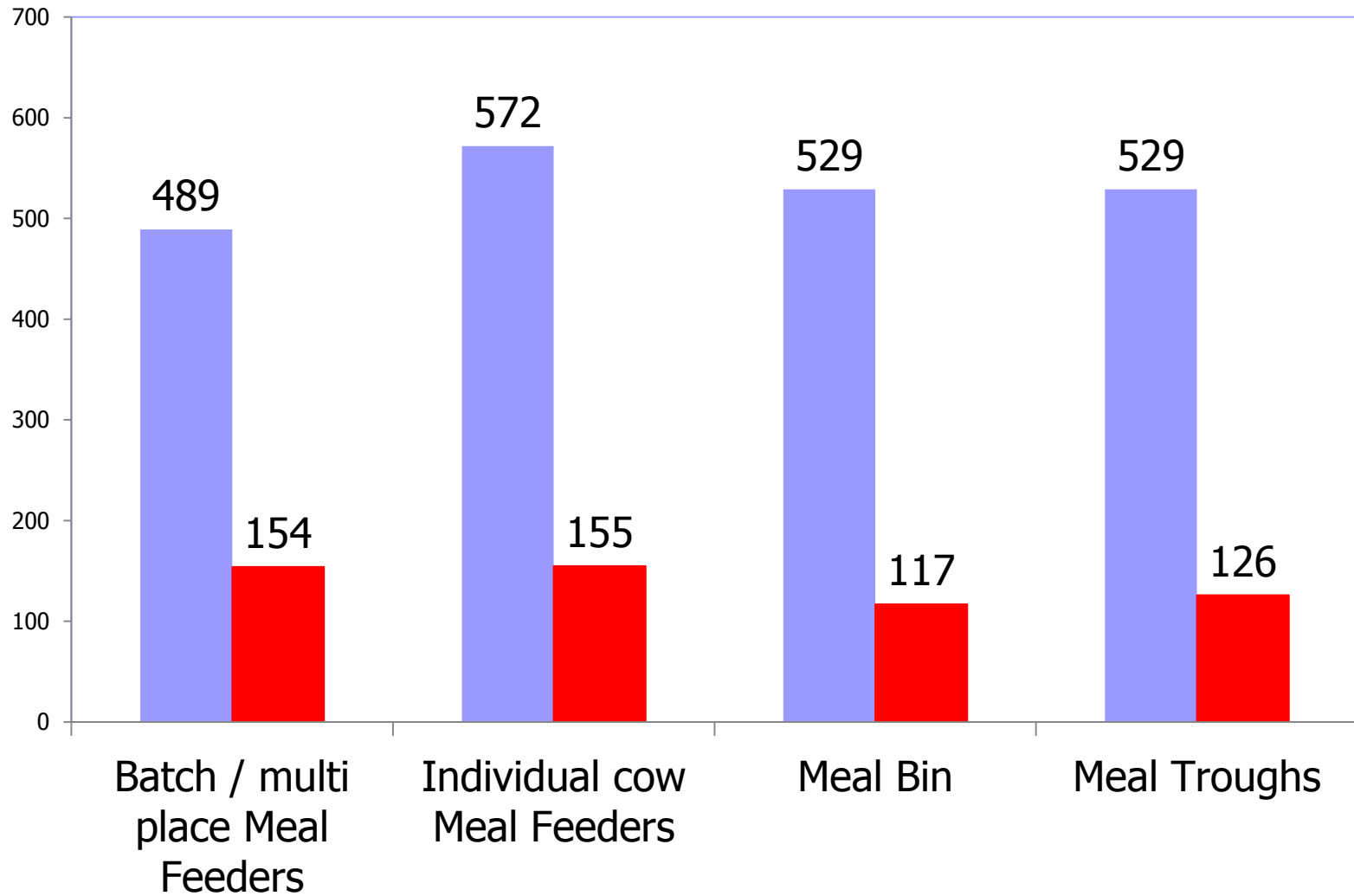
Cooling and storage equipment

Scheme Revision

- Completion period reduced 6 or 12 months
 - 6 months = Auto Washer, Water Heating
 - 12 months = Milking equipment, cooling equipment & In parlour feeding system
 - Application with a minimum of 1 investment for 12 months approval- all investment will automatically be 12 mts

Scheme Revision

- Penalty for work started or purchases made prior to approval
 - < 20% - rejection of relevant receipted amount
 - 20%-50%- rejection of investment
 - >50% - rejection of application

Important Reminders

- All cost is exclusive of Vat (Ex. Vat)
- Trade-In -
 - Like for Like (tank for tank)
 - A Trade-In is an acceptable form of payment
 - Must be clearly document on receipt

Important Reminders (cont.)

- NO- Cash Payment, Hire purchase or Leasing
- Must purchase outright (after approval)
- Payment from APPLICANTS bank account
- Copy of Bank accounts will be requested

Contractors Tax Clearance (eTC)

- Contractor's tax clearance required if contracting cost exceeds €650
- Contractor must register eTC with Department
- Register once by completing CCS CR/CY form (see back of scheme T&C) and emailing to TAMSIIcontractors@agriculture.gov.ie

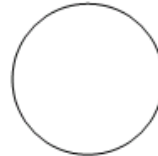
